

Leadership recertification: the credit system

The Society has assigned a credit value to the courses and activities listed below. The credit value and status of these courses may change as modifications are made by the organization responsible. Because of this, an because new training programs are continually being developed, the credit list is updated from time to time. Courses and training programs which do not currently appear on the credit list may be eligible for credit value. In-service and pre-season training offered by employers are often given credit. To request recognition of such courses, fill out the *Application for Credit* form, and submit it to the Society for approval.

Make sure your credit card is validated and sent to the Lifesaving Society with your recertification fees, as described in our current price list, found online. Recertifying Examiner status is free when done at the same time as the corresponding Instructor status.

You may not "save" extra credits for next time – after you submit your credit card, any additional credits expire; you start with zero credits for the next 2 year recertification period.

During the two year recertification period, accumulate 3 credits by participating in your choice of courses, clinics and training programs. Credits may be selected directly from the credit list below, or you may apply to have a specific course assigned a credit value by the Society. Three credits are required to recertify, regardless of how many leadership awards you hold, or are recertifying simultaneously. Lifesaving and Swim Instructors may select their credits from any item on the list. Instructors of National Lifeguard, First Aid, BOAT, and Boat Rescue programs must select their credits only from those in category B. Examiners must include a minimum of one credit marked in the *Examiner* column. Instructor Trainers must have taught an Instructor course. *Note*: each item or recertification of each item may be applied only once during each 2 year recertification period. Recertification of any item listed below is worth one credit.
